



# Fire Safety Info For Tuff Truck Campers

The Bushfire Danger Period is between the 1st September and 31st March 2009. All campers are advised that during Tuff Truck, the only fires allowed to be lit without a Fire Safety Permit is a Camp Fire.

All other fires require a fire permit to be issued and the lighting of any fire (other than a camp fire) without a permit is illegal.

If caught lighting a fire (other than a camp fire) without a permit you may be liable to a fine of up to \$500.

## Rules for Camp fires at Tuff Truck

- Camp fires should be sited at least 3 meters away from tents and other structures.
- Must have a 3 meter clearance free from leaf and grass fuels.
- Not be larger than 1.5 meters in diameter & no higher than 1.5 meters.
- No liquid fuels (Petrol etc) should be used to light a fire as this is a dangerous practice and will result in injury.
- Water supply or a fire extinguisher should be on hand to extinguish fires if they become out of control
- ALL fires to be fully extinguished before leaving the Tuff Truck site.
- A responsible person not affected by alcohol to be present at the camp fire at all times.

The NSW Rural Fire Service and Tuff Truck organisers are looking for all campers to support them in using fire in a safe manner & adhering to the rules.
